In January 2024, a five-year graduate survey was mailed to 318 undergraduates who graduated between January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019. Eight surveys were returned as undeliverable because the addresses were incorrect and forwarding time had expired, or we did not have a complete address. Of the remaining 310 surveys, 19 (6.1%) were completed and returned. Not everyone answered every question. Survey results to selected questions are contained in the following tables:
